

How to Setup your iPhone with Integral's Mail Server

Enclosed are instructions on how to setup your iPhone on icmailbox.com.

Go to Settings



Select Mail, Contacts, Calendars



Select Add Account



Select **Other** on the screen below



Select **Add Mail Account**



Enter your name, email account, and password

Choose **POP** instead of IMAP so POP is Blue



Incoming Mail Server



Enter the following Information:

Incoming Mail Server

Host name – icmailbox.com

Username: emailaddress@youremaildomain.com

Password

Outgoing Mail Server

Host name – icmailbox.com


Username: emailaddress@youremaildomain.com

Password

Click SAVE

The phone will then start Verifying the information you entered.

Your phone will tell you it cannot connect using SSL, do you want to continue to try setting up the account without SSL, respond YES.



Next, In the Mail Contacts Calendars, select the Email Account you just created, "icmailbox"



Under Outgoing Mail Server is SMTP icmailbox.com, click on the icmailbox.com



Click on the "ON" text next to Primary Server icmailbox.com



Make sure the Server Port at the bottom is set to 587 and not 25, then click Done



Some email services such as ATT and Comcast may block you from sending email on Server Port 25 as part of their anti-spam defenses. By changing it to 587 you have a much better chance of sending emails troublefree.
